<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4,000+ young professionals, leading change in multiple sectors across Canada • 80% are 18-24 years' old • 62% Female, 36% Male • 80% make under \$50,000 a year • 59% will attend a Canadian university in the next 12 months • 12% work in Government/Politics • 91% do not have children • 81% would change a purchasing decision, price and quality being equal, based on Support of Forum for Young Canadians 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20,000+ lead business, politics and more across the nation (11 sitting MP's includes 5 Cabinet Ministers) • 40% are 31-40 years' old • 51% Male, 48% Female • 36% Make \$100,000 or more a year • 44% are Graduate educated, 40% are Undergraduate educated • 66% own their homes • 26% work in Government & Politics • 70% would change a purchasing decision, price and quality being equal, based on support of Forum for Young Canadians
